Description of role.	Providing telephone support and sign posting to the women we are supporting.  Providing a listening ear, a non judgmental conversation and showing support.
How your call helps?	Just knowing someone will contact you on a regular basis can make a genuine difference to your wellbeing. It can provide reassurance, comfort, companionship, emotional support and a

	means of obtaining information about other avenues of support if required.  We are looking for confident communicators who are good at listening. The befriending line is to listen and empathise but not to give advice.  DBS is required.
Skills/ Qualifications	Outgoing, friendly and proactive character. Be comfortable volunteering within a group or by yourself. Good communication skills. Being able to use your own initiative but be able to ask for help when you need
Commitment	We require a minimum of 4 months commitment. 4 hours a week.
